



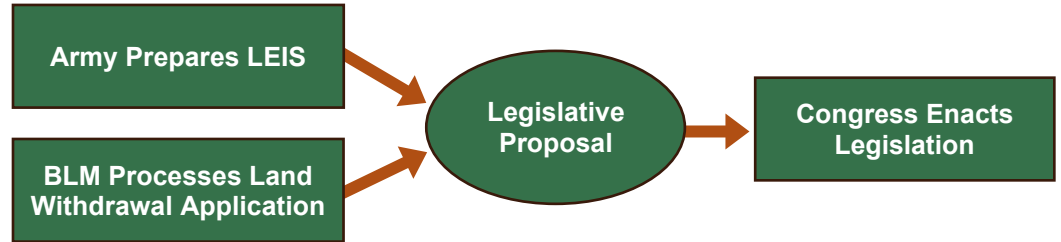
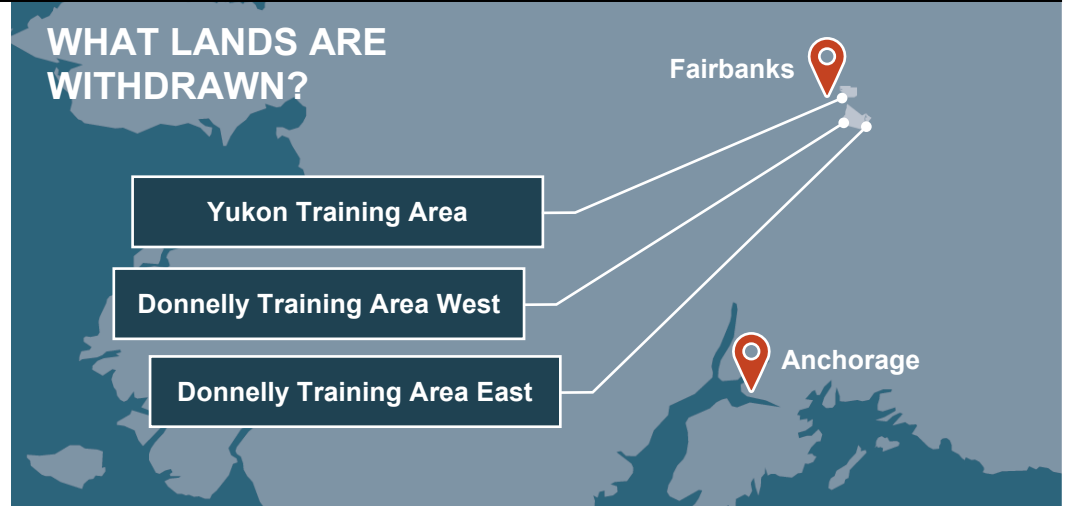

Legislative Environmental Impact Statement for Land Withdrawal Extension at U.S. Army Garrison Alaska

OVERVIEW

The Department of the Army (Army) intends to prepare a Legislative Environmental Impact Statement (LEIS) to assess potential impacts of the continued military use of withdrawn land in Alaska for 25 years or more, or assigning control of the land to the Secretary of the Army until such time as the Army determines it no longer needs the land for military purposes. The current withdrawal will expire in 2026 unless Congress enacts legislation to extend it. The information presented in the LEIS will support Congress' decision on the legislative proposal. The U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has agreed to be a cooperating agency in preparation of this LEIS.
